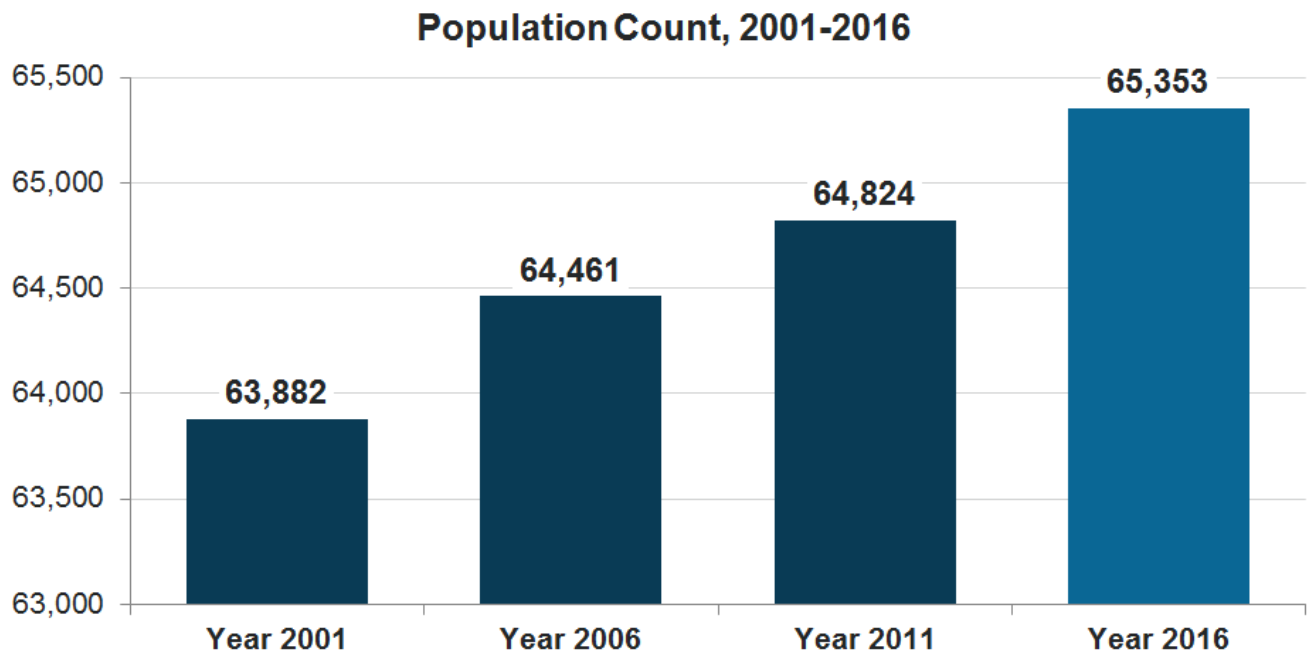

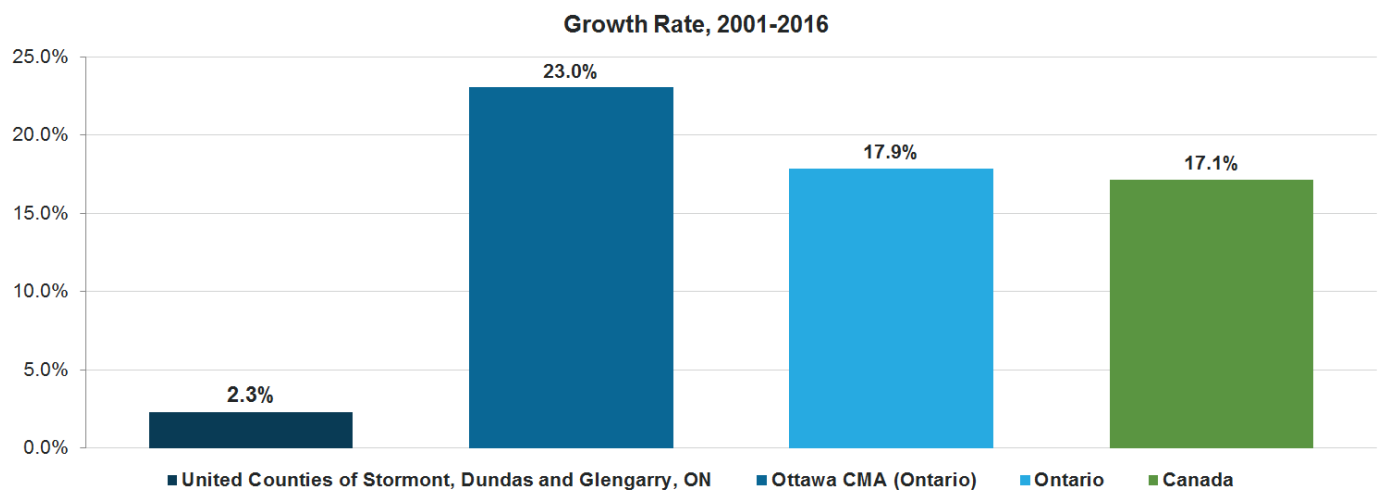
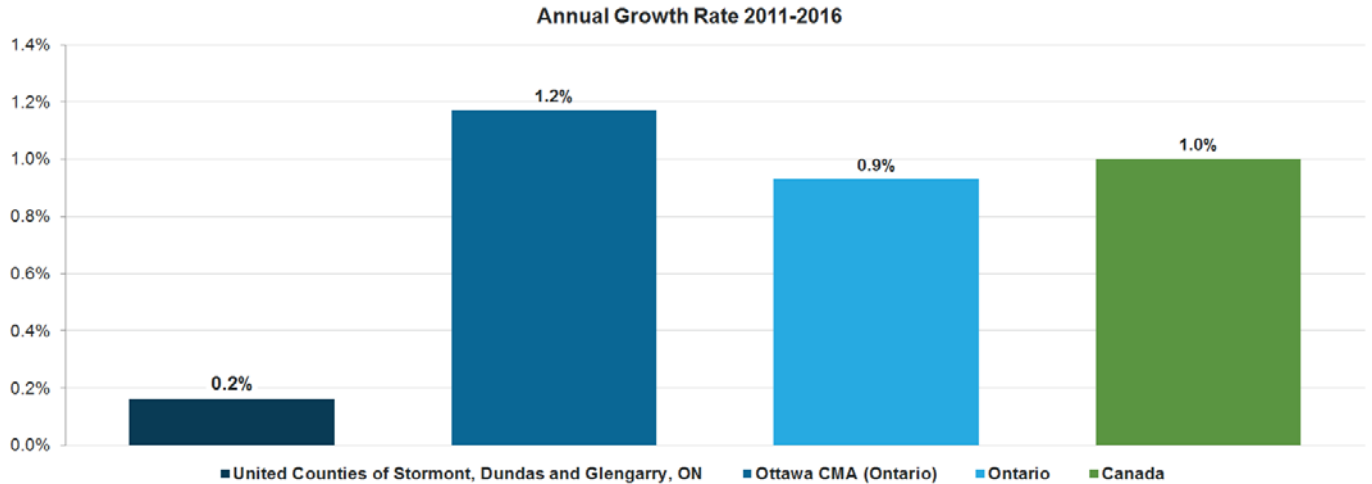
- In 2016, the United Counties of Stormont, Dundas and Glengarry had a population of 65,353, representing a percentage change of 0.8% from 2011. This compares to the provincial average growth of 4.6%.
- In the last 15 years, the United Counties of Stormont, Dundas and Glengarry has had a total population growth of 1,471. The community of South Stormont had the largest growth (1,169).
- In the last 5 years, the average annual growth rate has been 0.2% or 106 residents per year. Comparatively, the Province has grown 0.9% per year, while Canada has grown 1.0% per year.

Quick Facts

- The United Counties of Stormont, Dundas and Glengarry are part of the census metropolitan area of Ottawa, which grew 5.9% in the last 5 years.
- South Glengarry is still the largest lower-tier municipality within the county, while North Stormont is the smallest lower-tier municipality.
- The fastest growing lower-tier municipality is South Stormont with 3.9% growth in the last 5 years.

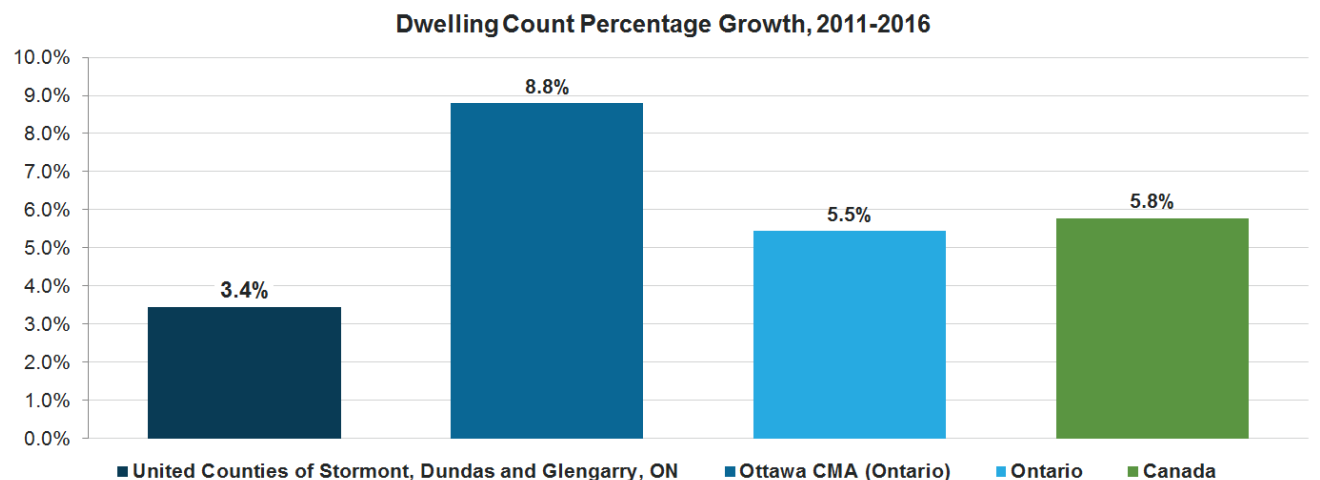
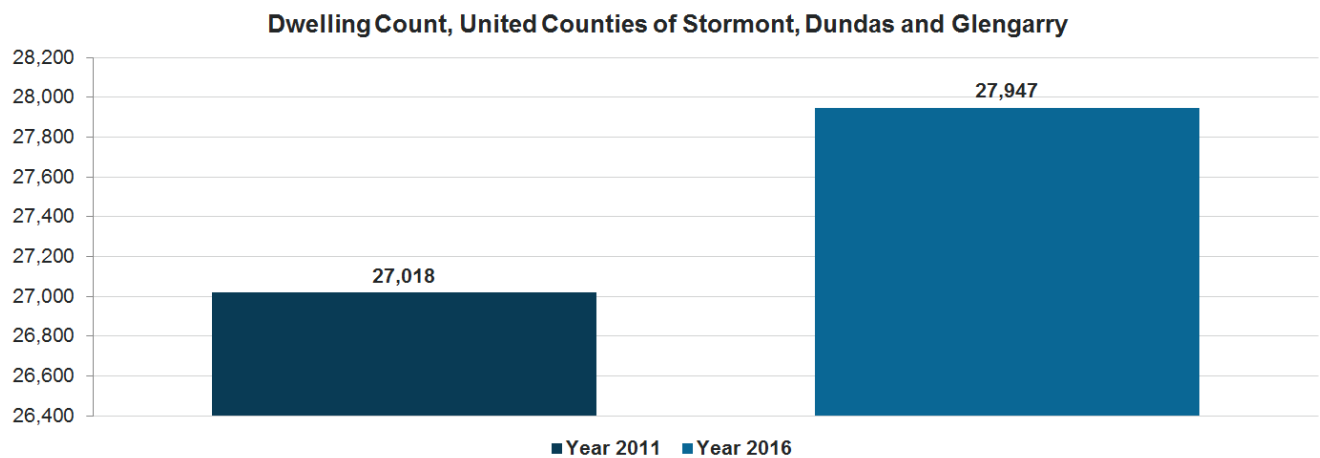

Quick Facts

- In 2016, the United Counties of Stormont, Dundas and Glengarry had 27,947 private dwellings. The change in private dwellings from 2011 was 3.4%. For the Ottawa CMA as a whole, the number of private dwellings increased 8.8%.
- The United Counties of Stormont, Dundas and Glengarry has a population density of 20.5 persons per square kilometre. This compares to the provincial density of 14.8 persons per square kilometre.
